

## Introduction

Dear DEI, QE or SI instructor,

General Education instructors across the university have been rising to the challenges posed by COVID-19 and we appreciate faculty's efforts to support student learning during these difficult times. In order to make participation in the ongoing assessment of General Education easier for faculty, the General Education Oversight Committee (GEOC) has made changes to options for assessment participation for the remainder of the semester. These changes were developed in alignment with the national conversation about adjusting learning assessment under COVID-19 conditions and were approved at the GEOC's March 26, 2020 meeting.

We recognize that instructors in Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI), Quantitative Experience (QE), and Social Inquiry (SI) courses have had to make many changes to adjust for this semester's COVID-19 disruptions, and that the planned Gen Ed assessment may have been affected as well. The committee wants to understand how those course-level changes might affect the Gen Ed program, which will inform GEOC planning for the future.

Completion of this survey about your course-level changes is one of the options for satisfying requirements for participating in Gen Ed assessment this semester. The other option is for instructors to submit assessment data using the rubric in your Canvas course.
